## Life as Sacred Journey

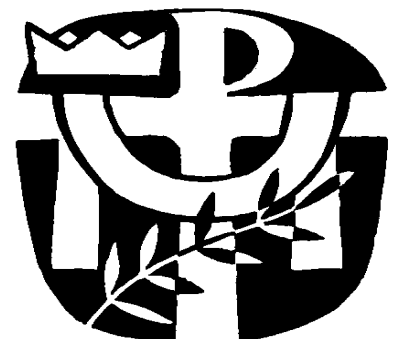

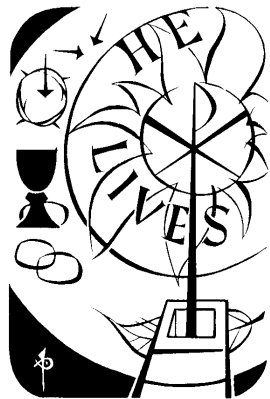
Never kill the dreams of children. Never our cold water on anyone's hope for a better future. And most important of all, courageously hold onto your own dreams for a life filled with the best.

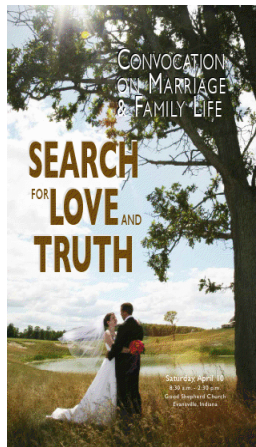
