What an outpouring generosity!

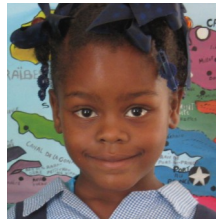

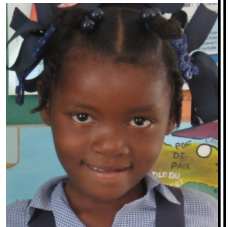
